Internship in Banská Bystrica, Slovakia

Summary: Assist Entrust staff serving local churches, discipling believers, offering camps and doing outreach among various people groups in and around Banská Bystrica.

Commitment: 6 to 12 weeks, plus online pre-service orientation and post-service debrief.

Location: Banská Bystrica, Slovakia

Funding: Raises support; \$1,500-\$2,500 depending on accommodation preference and length of stay (which will cover all expenses during deployment), plus roundtrip airfare.

- Learn some of the local language, history and culture while in the country.
- Assist in planning and conducting youth camps.
- Participate in local church and campus youth ministries.
- Participate in outreach, evangelism and discipleship groups.
- Participate in regional Entrust field meetings and conferences.

- Local believers will be encouraged and will grow in their walk with Christ.
- Non-believers will be exposed to winsome, culturally appropriate expressions of the gospel.
