Internship in Vienna, Austria

Summary: Assists the pastor and ministry leaders at International Chapel of Vienna, an English-speaking congregation including a wide spectrum of international people.

Reports to: Entrust Austria country leaders and the pastor of International Chapel of Vienna

Commitment: 6 to 12 weeks, plus online pre-service orientation and post-service debrief.

Location: Vienna, Austria

Funding: Raises support: \$1,200 / month (which will cover all expenses during deployment), plus roundtrip

airfare.

- Assist in planning and conducting children's camp.
- Participate in youth or children's ministries.
- Participate in outreach, evangelism and discipleship.
- Assist with worship music or church sound system, if desired.
